FROM THE RECTOR TO PARISHIONERS – THIS SUNDAY:

This Sunday at 10:30 a.m. (in the course of the sermon) and (more briefly) at 8 a.m., after the blessing, I wish to share with you my thoughts about a particular decision that lies before the parish, and the opportunity we have to make a big step in building up this congregation. I know it is June, and many of you are tied up with summer events, if you are not out of town. *Nonetheless, I request that you make a special effort to be in church, even if it requires you to re-organize your time.* The gospel lesson for this Sunday proclaims, “Come, for all things are now ready” – a theme echoed in the Ralston favourite we shall sing, “Come and dine”: it is my earnest request, and my hope, that you will respond to that call.

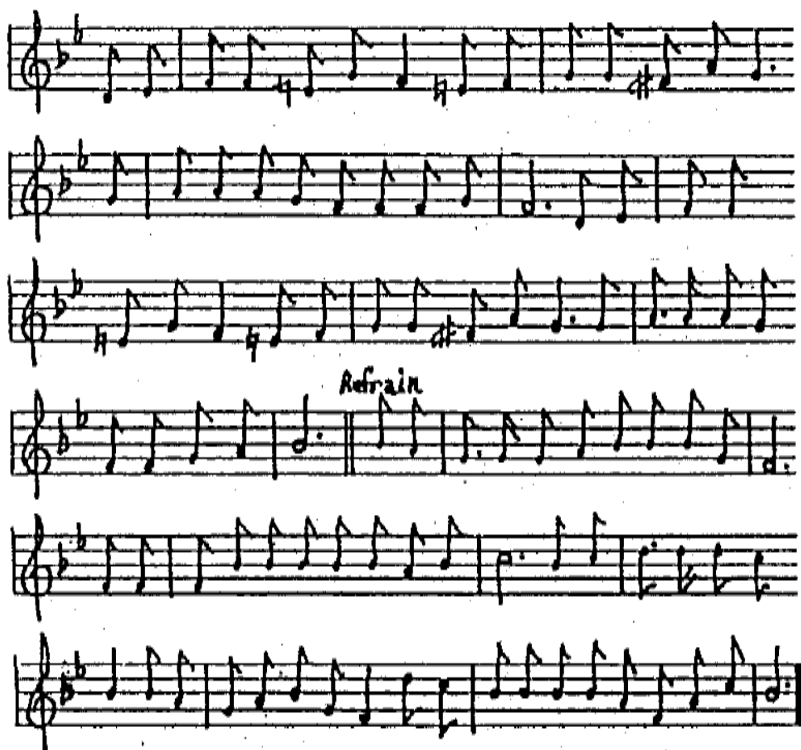
