Our aim, in the choral service of evensong, is to offer beauty in song to God, the giver of all beauty and goodness. Based on the daily choral worship offered since ancient times, choral Evensong in its Anglican form has been sung regularly in the cathedrals and greater parish churches since the sixteenth century. In a choral service, the musical parts of the congregation are sung on their behalf by the choir. Our participation is the silent offering of our hearts and minds through the music they sing. We do however join the choir in saying the Confession, first Lord's Prayer, and Apostles' Creed; in the Amen in the prayers after the Anthem, and in the singing of hymns.
