Program Schedule: Thursday evenings (and some Tuesday evenings) from 6 to 8 p.m. beginning Thursday, June 6. [A definitive schedule will be determined at the first meeting.] Youth Guides meet from 6 to 8 p.m. in preparation to give tours to the public on Saturday, July 27.

Open to: Students ages 14 to 18 (rising 9th graders through high school)

Qualifications:

- *An interest in art, history, architecture, and/or historic preservation
- *A pledge to participate in the program and give at least one tour to the public
- *The commitment to fulfill volunteer duties in an appropriate manner

Benefits:

- *Working with the public in a historic house setting
- *Making friends with other Youth Guides, historic house staff and volunteers
- *Meeting people from all over the United States and the world
- *Experiencing a popular tourist site
- *Training in tour-giving techniques and the history of the Green Meldrim House
- *Learning about: 19th century history and the development of Savannah, Civil War history and Savannah, people associated with the Green Meldrim House including Susie King Taylor, historic preservation, urban slavery, public speaking and communication skills, careers in cultural resource management.
